Nacogdoches firefighters have all returned safely after a weeklong deployment to Childress, Texas to support wildfire operations. Firefighters deployed as part of a Texas Intrastate Fire Mutual Aid System (TIFMAS) request and all costs including overtime, backfill and equipment will be reimbursed by the State.

Nacogdoches Fire & Rescue completed our bi-annual compliance inspection by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection last week. The inspection is required by Chapter 419 of the Texas Government Code

and includes an extensive review of policies, procedures and personal protective equipment. The Commission found that NFD met all compliance requirements and State regulations related to firefighters.

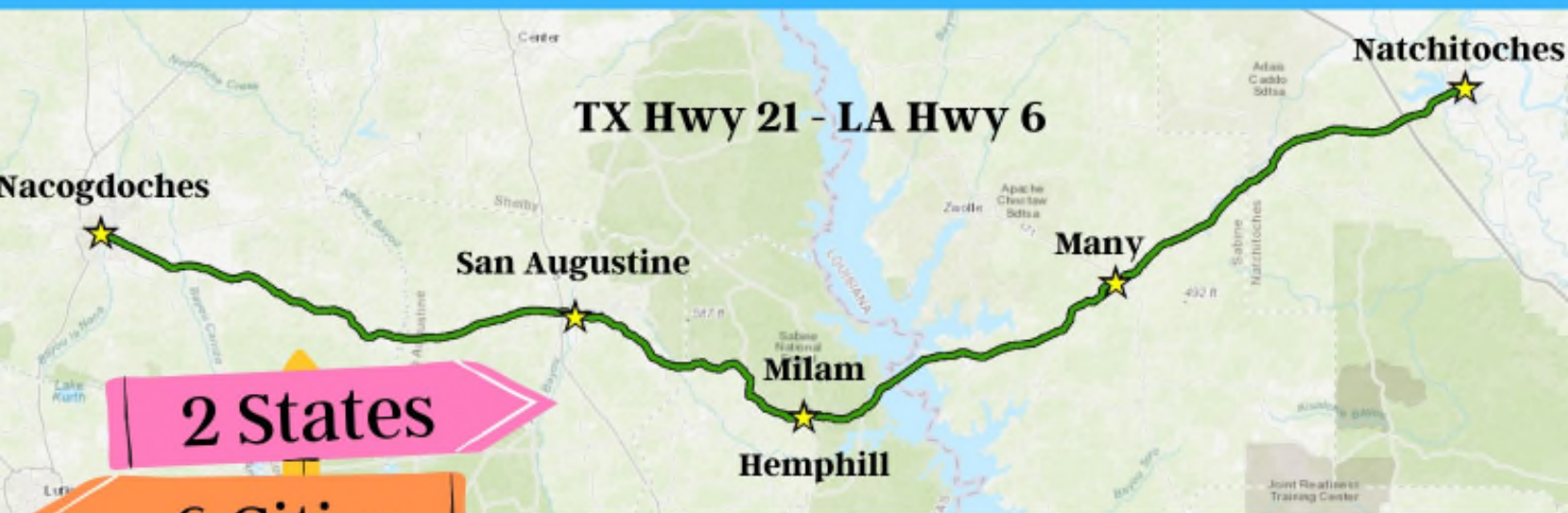
