The public library computers continue to be highly utilized. From April 12 to May 12, 1,744 sessions were logged. The Cybrarian scheduling software used by the library tracks the number of computer sessions, session lengths, and records when computers are used most during the day. Most libraries use scheduling software because it helps the library provide equitable access to computers by setting time limits on sessions when demand is high. The Cybrarian software also provides wireless printing, which is very helpful for many people who use their smartphones as their primary access to the Internet. The

library also checks-out hotspots and chromebooks to assist customers with digital access. For more information about these services, please contact library staff at 936-559-2970.
